

Learning Overview



Reading, Writing, Spelling & Grammar

In English this half term, we will be reading the book, Arthur and the Golden Rope. We will be immersing ourselves in the story, analysing the text and using what we have found to help us write our own myth narrative and information guide to defeating a Viking monster. We will be learning how to organise our writing using paragraphs and focusing on apostrophes for possession, conjunctions and expanded noun phrases in grammar.

RE

In RE, we will be learning all about Jesus as the Son of God. We will investigate why Christians believe Jesus is the son of God and explore why Jewish people consider the sabbath to be so important.

Maths- Fluency, Reasoning & Problem Solving

In maths, we will return to the core skill of using place value (working on decimal places) as well as working on multiplication, divisions and fractions using both mental and written methods.

We will of course be continuing to work daily on our times tables and being able to know remember and recall multiplication facts quickly and accurately.

Art

We will be exploring the still life form and using a variety of mediums to recreate still life images and sculptures.

Science

In science, we will be studying materials, their properties and changes in properties, focusing on solids, liquids and gases and how one form changes into another. This will involve lots of investigation work!

Computing

Computing will be delivered by Junior Jam this half term.

PSHE

Dreams, goals and resolutions will be the focus of PSHE in the new year. We will encourage the children to identify their dreams and goals and help them identify how to achieve them.

In Geography, we will be studying France and making comparisons between France and England, looking at the social aspects and the physical aspects.
