

# Learning Overview



## Reading, Writing, Spelling & Grammar

We will be exploring the texts, 'The Witches' and 'The Whale', recounting real or imagined events and using descriptive language to create a fictional setting. We will also be working on comprehension skills daily through shared reading time and will be looking at a variety of non-fiction texts early on in the half-term, moving towards fictional narratives.

## RE

In RE, we will explore churches, their role in Christianity and the differences between different churches looking at the idea that not all churches are the same.

## Maths- Fluency, Reasoning & Problem Solving

We will be working on our knowledge of place value, ensuring children understand why, for example, a number might have a zero in the middle and how the number's value would change if the zero was not there. We will also work on the skill of exchange, applying this knowledge to written addition and subtraction.

## Art

This half-term, our work in art will focus on storytelling and using art to do this. We will be creating our own art work to communicate stories to our audience.

## Science

In science this half-term, we will describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans.

We will also identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions, as well as exploring the relationships between predators and their prey.

## Computing

Our computing curriculum will be delivered by Junior Jam and this half-term, they will be working on 'iJam'.

## Geography

Our Geography work will be based on natural disasters. We will look specifically at volcanoes, tornadoes and tsunamis.

## PSHE

In PSHE, we will think about ourselves and our place in the world, include work on our rights and responsibilities.

## Music

Our music work will be delivered by Junior Jam and we will be working on musical theory, using keyboards to support this objective.
