## **Learning Overview**

As we move further into the Spring Term (and hopefully warmer weather), we will be continuing with our hard work across all subject areas.

In English, our focus will be on myths and legends and the book, 'The Lost Happy Endings'. We will use the book to help us write a 'twisted narrative' and a persuasive letter. This theme will be continued in shared reading.

In maths, we will be working on using formal written methods to add and subtract, as well as learning about 2D shape, position and direction, area, statistics and measures.

In Science we will continue learning about states of matter. In History we will learn about a different type of state- the city states of Ancient Greece. In RE we will explore the themes of betrayal and trust through the Easter Story. In DT we are designing and making an electrical product. In PSHE we will be thinking about healthy relationships and choices.
