

# Learning Overview



## Reading, Writing, Spelling & Grammar

First, we will write an explanation text using our knowledge of evolution and adaptation. We will then begin a new book, which is called 'The Ways of the Wolf', where the children will take part in a balanced argument to develop their speaking and listening skills. Shared reading will continue to develop our inference skills.

## Maths- Fluency, Reasoning & Problem Solving

In maths, we will begin with an algebra focus; moving onto calculating ratios; solving problems involving statistics; learning about the properties of 2D and 3D shapes and converting between measurements.

## Science

The animals including humans topic will continue this half term where the children will have a focus on staying healthy. This will encourage the children to think carefully about a healthy diet and exercise and how both affect the human body.

## History

In history, the children will learn about the Vikings. Through exploration of the lifestyle of a Viking family, they will be able to explain whether they think all Vikings were brutal warriors.

## RE

We will explore what Easter is and who Jesus was. Using the bible, we will think about the influence this has on the world and how Easter is celebrated.

## Design Technology

In design technology, we will investigate how structures and mechanisms work. We will look at existing structure and evaluate them.

## Computing

Computing will be covered by Junior Jam. The children will be using the iPads to develop their skills when creating media.

## PSHE

We will have a strong focus on how to be respectful of other people this half term. We will then look at how we can live a healthy lifestyle.

## Music

Music will be taught by Junior Jam. The children will have a focus on singing as a choir.
