We are lucky to have Mrs Bell supporting us during our maths lesson every morning.

In English, we will be studying the use of grammar within our writing. Next, we will complete a writing unit based on several different genres.

Our mathematics will recap our previous learning in preparation for our SATs tests. We will learn to apply our skills to solve challenging problems.

In science, we will be learning about electricity and then move on to studying light and the human eye.

Our computing will have a focus on spreadsheets. The children will be collecting and collating data to input into Purple Mash.

The children will continue learning to develop their skills in French, with a focus on where we live.

Our PE lessons will consist of the children learning the skills to play cricket and rounders and they will take part in outdoor athletics activities.

During our history lessons, the children will continue to learn about the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings. We will then focus on refining our geographical skills.

Your child may have been invited to attend a SATS booster session. Please ensure they attend each session if you have received this information.

Homework:

- Homework will be sent home each Friday and will be linked to a revision topic in the lead up to SATS.
- As well as this, the children are expected to read at home every night for approximately 20 minutes.
- Also, the children in year 6 are expected to know all their times tables up to 12x12. They will be tested on a Friday morning. Times Table Rockstars is a great way to practise times tables.

Year 6 P.E. days are as follows:
