

Learning Overview



Reading, Writing, Spelling & Grammar

The children will be studying the text of Rose Blanche. They will explore diary writing and will write persuasive speeches whilst immersed in the text. There will be a focus on the basics of handwriting and grammar, ensuring that the skills are embedded throughout each topic.

RE

Life as a journey will be our first topic where the children will explore journeys in all walks of life, from local journeys to religious journeys around the world and the events in our lives.

Maths- Fluency, Reasoning & Problem Solving

The children will recap their skills of addition and subtraction, which will lead into problem solving. After this, the children will learn about place value and how to read and manipulate numbers above 1 million. The children will then practise their skills when multiplying numbers using a written method and will learn how to solve algebraic problems.

Art

The children will develop their mastery of art and design techniques by using typography to enlarge scale drawings. The children will study the artist Claire Harrup and the influence she has on the art world.

Science

Throughout our science lessons, the children will be exploring how animals have adapted over time to suit the environments they now live in. Through investigating how animals have adapted, the children will be able to describe the features they have inherited and how they have evolved.

Computing

Computing will be taught by Junior Jam where the first topic is [iJam](#). This covers all things music, from producing your own song, creating your own Hip-Hop rap or remixing two songs together.

Geography

Year Six will explore the world and locate different countries. This will lead onto the study of biomes and what plants are able to grow in these habitats.

PSHE

The children will identify goals for the year ahead and learn how to be the best global citizen they can be. They will then learn how it is good to be unique and celebrate differences.

Music

Music will be taught by Junior Jam where the children will learn music theory with keyboards. The children will then build their music skills to create a musical performance using the keyboards.
