Task 2

Research an animal which has adapted to its environment. The more unusual, the better or make up your own creature and explain how it has adapted to its surroundings. Draw the creature then label the features.

Task 3

Research the scientist Charles Darwin and create a fact file about his life, his scientific achievements and his findings. You can include drawings and writing.

Task 4

Create a poster about the different animal groups. Be sure to include (at least) mammals, birds, insects, amphibians and fish. Make sure you present your poster in an interesting way for the reader.

Task 5

Create a fact file about your favourite animal. Why is it your favourite? Which animal group does it belong to? You can include drawings, writing and even photographs.

Task 6

Who was Rose Blanche?
Write a non-chronological report about her.
