

### Year 3

1. **Progression Across the Year:** Focuses on advancing narrative skills with themes like fables and settings. Non-narrative formats such as explanations and recounts are also introduced.
2. **Skills Progression:** Emphasis on using prefixes, selecting appropriate articles (a/an), and forming expanded noun phrases. Develops use of conjunctions and prepositions to show cause, time, and place.
3. **Genre Progression:** Genres covered include approach threat narratives, fables, and recounts, encouraging diversity in narrative and informational writing.
4. **Vocabulary:** Introduction of common prefixes (auto-, super-, anti-) and vocabulary related to specific genre topics.

### Year 4

1. **Progression Across the Year:** Builds on storytelling through varied narratives, including myth and twisted narrative styles. Informative writing like reports and persuasive letters also emphasised.
2. **Skills Progression:** Expands on noun phrases with modifiers, fronted adverbials, and accurate verb inflections, supporting coherent and structured sentence construction.
3. **Genre Progression:** Genres like myths and refugee narratives encourage complex storytelling, while informative genres strengthen descriptive and persuasive skills.
4. **Vocabulary:** Reinforces standard English forms and differentiates plural from possessive -s, enriching precise communication.

### Year 5

1. **Progression Across the Year:** Increases narrative complexity with settings, dilemmas, and character-driven stories. Thematic writing includes formal letters, balanced arguments, and guides.
2. **Skills Progression:** Introduction of modal verbs for possibility, relative clauses, and expanded noun phrases for detailed descriptions. Cohesion within paragraphs is emphasised.
3. **Genre Progression:** Genres include exploration narratives, formal reports, and survival guides, blending fictional and real-world applications of language.
4. **Vocabulary:** Expanded vocabulary choices with a focus on formal/informal language distinctions, verb prefixes, and suffixes for verb formation.

### Year 6

1. **Progression Across the Year:** Includes dual narratives and flashbacks, adding depth to storytelling. Varied writing purposes such as persuasion, explanation, and balanced arguments are central.
2. **Skills Progression:** Focus on complex sentence structures, including passive voice and subjunctive forms, with refined cohesion techniques across paragraphs.

## Progression- Skill, Genre and Vocabulary

3. **Genre Progression:** Genres include documentary-style narratives and endurance stories, coupled with sophisticated informational writing, like biographies and adaptation explanations.
4. **Vocabulary:** Emphasis on synonyms, antonyms, and formal vocabulary choices. Expands to advanced punctuation (semi-colons, colons, hyphens) for nuanced expression.
